DOGGY BLISS

1. Your dog will act like a dog. Don't take it personally when she exhibits typical dog behavior. She's not being bad she's just being a dog. Supply your dog with acceptable outlets for her doggy behavior rather than punishing her.
2. Dogs are happiest when exercising their skills. Make him work for his food. Hide it in a Kong toy or around the house, throw it all over the floor so he has to run around to get it. Teach him tricks, rewarding with food.
3. Take the leash off! In a safe place such as your fenced yard or dog park or pet friendly trail. Let them feel the wind in their fur.
4. Provide plenty of opportunities to play with other dogs. They need to interact with others of their own kind.
5. Never hit or yell at your dog, instead use reward based training.
6. Play with your dog, fetch, Frisbee, hide n seek, get down on his level.
7. There is no such thing as an outside dog. The worst punishment a person can get in prison is solitary confinement.
8. Handle your puppy endlessly in a pleasant way so she will associate it with good feelings.
9. Spay or neuter your dog so they will be less focused on territory, mating or roaming and more focused on the family. He will be healthier and friendlier.
10. Enroll in a reward based training course, it is fun, teaches her how to behave and encourages her to bond with you.
